

## Admission Procedure

- **Qualifying marks to submit the application form: Arts Stream:** A minimum of 60% marks in aggregate in Assamese, English and Social Science or overall 60% marks in HSLC /Class-X Board Examination is required to apply.  
**Science Stream:** A minimum of 60% marks in aggregate in English, General Mathematics and General Science or overall 60% marks in HSLC /Class-X Board Examination is required to apply.
- Application form is available with the school prospectus.  
The prospectus may be obtained from the school office (9am to 2pm) on all working days as specified in the notice.
- The application form must be accompanied by photocopies of the following documents- i) HSLC/Class-X Board Examination marksheet and certificate, ii) Two copies of recent passport sized photograph, iii) Admit card of HSLC Examination, iv) Character certificate from the Head of the institution last attended, v) Migration certificate for students migrating from other board/university, vi) Gap certificate (for candidate who passed the HSLC Examination earlier than 2026)
- No application will be accepted after the last date of submission of forms.  
Incomplete application forms without self attested photocopies of required testimonials will be turned down.
- **The seat of any student may be cancelled if he/she is continuously absent for 10 days in the class without prior permission from the Vice-Principal (HS) and his/her admission fee etc, will be treated as forfeited.**

## Admission Requirements

- Original copies of all testimonials are to be produced at the time of admission for the process of verification.
- Required fees must be paid at the time of admission.
- Presence of parents or guardians is mandatory at the time of admission.  
Two passport sized coloured photographs must be produced at the time of admission.

## Attendance Requirements

- In order to be eligible to appear in the class-XI Annual Examination and Higher Secondary Final Examination, every student must attend a minimum of 90% lectures/practicals held during the academic session.
- The names of students grossly irregular in attendance will be struck off from the school register.

## Discipline:

Disciplined, dignified manners and proper decorum in and outside the school campus are expected from each and every student.

Violation of any school rule will be severely dealt with.

The students shall take proper care of school property, furniture and premises and should not cause any damage to the school property.

It is mandatory for students to come to school in proper uniform.

**Use of mobile phone, calculator, camera, laptop, smoking, spitting is strictly prohibited in the school campus.**

## Monitoring academic progress:

The Principal and the faculty members of the school will meet the students as well as the guardians on convenient dates during the academic session to make first hand assessment of academic progress or any problems related to teaching and learning.

The school solicits an active co-operation from the guardians in every academic matters.

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Academic Calendar for the session 2025-26 will be given to the students at the time of admission.

## LESSON PLAN:

A lesson plan for the whole academic year will be provided to the students.

## SCHOOL MAGAZINE:

The school magazine "Bakhar" is published every year. A monthly magazine "Anweshan" is also published regularly.

## EXAMINATION:

For both classes XI and XII, there will be unit tests of 25 marks each are held as per academic calendar of the school. Class XI annual examination and class XII pre-final examination are held as per ASSEB (Div-II) examination schedule. Class tests of 15 marks are conducted department wise during the session twice in a month. Special test for class XII students are held every Monday.

- Students obtaining 90% or above marks in unit tests, class XI annual examination, class XII pre-final examination are eligible to get 50% fee concession. (Conditions apply).

## CUET (UG) Classes

### WHY CUET ?

Admissions to central and state government colleges and universities for various undergraduate degree programs (B.Sc, B.A, B.com, BMS, BBA etc) are no more dependent only on the boards marks at higher secondary level. Admissions to these institutions now also look into student's performance in Common University Entrance Test (CUET) organised by National Testing Agency (NTA). The National Testing Agency has been mandated by the Ministry of Education and UGC to conduct the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes in Central Universities under the Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities / Institutions / Organizations / Autonomous Colleges. The CUET (UG) provides a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organisations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country.

### CUET EXAM PATTERN:

All Questions are of MCQ pattern

Exam would be conducted in hybrid mode

[Computer based test (CBT) or pen & paper]

Exam would be conducted in 13 languages including English and Assamese

There are three sections in the paper:

Section 1 - Language test (33 different options)

Section 2 - Domain test (27 subjects option)

Section 3 - General test

## House System:

There is a House System in our school. All the students of the school from class I to XII have been included in four houses namely Kaziranga House, Raimona House, Patkai House and Jatinga House.

The objectives of creating the House System are to develop the sense of responsibility, discipline and leadership among the students. The students have to wear their respective House uniform twice a week on Wednesday and Saturday. Moreover, the students have to wear their respective House uniform on all the Divas and programmes which are held in our school.

## General Academic Characteristics of the High School Section

- The teacher-student ratio is maintained at 1:20. A fixed number of 40 students are admitted into a section from pre-school to class X.
- The examination schedule consists of unit tests, half-yearly examination and the annual examination. Special tests are held for the students of class X and XII.
- Students in the Pre-school are admitted through lottery since 1994, the first school to adopt lottery system in the state of Assam.
- Students are not subjected to any test in the Pre-school. Their developments are observed on a continuous basis as per NCERT guidelines.
- Montessori play-way methods guide the teachers to teach the kids in the Pre-school.
- Written examination begins from class I.
- Students perform experiments in the science lab from Class III to class VIII on the basis of practical books authored by the teachers. Every student performs about 15 experiments in one year. In class IX students perform experiments in Environmental Science also.
- Assam History is taught, additionally, in the classes from V to VII.
- English is a subject from class I along with regular Spoken English classes from class III to X.
- The students are introduced to the lives of the great scientists in the classes from V to VII with the help of a specially prepared textbook.
- Computer Science classes are held in VII and VIII. The students are assessed twice a year online.
- Lessons from history of science are taught to the students of class VIII ; classes are held on the basis of a specially prepared textbook.
- The students are assessed continuously in Fine Arts, Craft, Science Practical and Spoken English.
- Geography, Computer Science, Advanced Mathematics, History, Music, Hindi, Fine Arts, Sanskrit and Dance are offered as elective subjects from class IX.
- The school follows a unique practice in which the students are not required to bring textbooks to the class. (When needed, students are advised to bring books for a specific reason.)
- Remedial classes are held on a regular basis.
- Guardians- teachers meet is held regularly.
- Performance of the school has been constantly very good in the High School Leaving Certificate Examination over the years. The school topped in 2008, and has a significant number of rank holders and highest marks in different subjects. The students perform very well in the internal examination also.
- One-day orientation programme is held twice every year for the teaching staff of the school, attended by invited resource persons.

- *Bakhar*, the school magazine is published annually with both students and teachers on the Editorial Board.
- *Anweshan*, a monthly magazine is being published since February, 2014 for the students primarily with the objective of enriching the students with current affairs and general knowledge.
- Every student learns (beginning in class II) one from the list of Tabla, Violin, Music (Vocal), Bharatnatyam, Fine Arts, Satriya dance, Sculpture, Guitar, Scout and Guide on Saturdays. The school follows its own syllabus, divided in four-part examination and completed in class X. Music classes are conducted under the banner of *Rupkonwar Sangeet Kanan* in memory of Jyotiprasad Agarwala and Fine Art Classes are organized under the banner of *Kalaguru Chitrasala* in memory of Bishnuprasad Rabha.
- Classes on General Knowledge and Mental Ability are held on Saturdays.
- Under the banner of *Einstein Bigyan Kendra* (Einstein Science Centre) students are given additional scope on Saturdays to learn skills of science experimentation. AJB students have excelled in National Children Science Congresses through presentation of innovative projects.
- Learning More Mathematics (*Mathematics Olympiad*) programme is organized on Saturdays to enhance interest in Mathematics for the willing students of class V to VIII divided in two groups.
- *Rasaraj sahitya sora*, a platform in memory of Lakshminath Bezbarua, the great modern Assamese literateur, involves teachers to motivate interested students to practise literary creation.
- The guardians of the kids, selected through lottery for admission into Pre-school, are given an orientation about the totality of the school to facilitate their decision-making before the admission process begins.
- The students from Class VII upwards, assess the performance of their teachers in a given format once a year. Management Committee interacts with the teachers on the basis of the assessment by the students.
- Monthly monitoring of academic progress is done through a structured format by the Management Committee.
- The Management Committee meets the staff members as per the academic calendar to discuss progress in lesson plan, examination results, self-improvement plan of the teachers and over-all environment of the school.
- The school has a system of Home Visit. The residence of a student is visited by the teachers three times during his/her stay of 12 years till class X. The observations are kept in record.
- Students are encouraged to set up Home Science Lab to develop the habit of experimentation and to carry out project work. On request, the teachers visit a student's Home Science Lab and prizes are awarded on selection basis.
- Important personalities are invited at regular intervals to interact and share their experiences with the students at various levels.
- A record book is provided to every student for communication between the teachers and the parents.



- On rotation basis, the teachers deliver lectures on Saturdays on selected topics for the entire faculty members.
- Special days like *Mahapurush Divas*, *Silpi Divas*, *Bishnu Rabha Divas*, *Teachers' Day*, *Lachit Divas*, *Swahid Divas*, *Bhogali Chora* and *Rongali Chora* are observed in the school with full participation of the students, teachers and parents / guardians.
- Science Day is observed every year with state-level competition in science projects, working models and experiments among the students of different schools. A magazine named *Prabhat* is published on the occasion.
- Literature Day is another event observed every year by organizing special lectures and state-level writing competition. A wall magazine is also brought out on the occasion.
- 5 November, the date of demise of legendary Assamese musician Dr. Bhupen Hazarika is celebrated in the school as 'Bhupen Hazarika Divas' to commemorate the great humanist.
- The school sponsors students' and teachers' visit to important scientific and historical places.
- The teachers have authored many books (published by the AJB Trust) to supplement the reading materials of the prescribed text books.
- An *Abhigyan Sibir* (Camp of Recollection) allows students of class X and XII to spend a night in the school after completion of their HSLC and HS examination respectively. The camp is marked by one or two invited lectures to prepare them for the immediate future. Informal musical night, games and other programmes make the camp enjoyable and unforgettable. In the valedictory function the students are made lifetime members of AJB family.
- The school has prepared a Science Kit Box for primary level and another for the secondary level. The former has materials for about 50 experiments and the latter for 100 plus experiments.
- The school has also prepared a Mathematical Kit Box that helps to explain 100 plus geometrical and algebraic relations. A Probability Kit Box has also been prepared.
- Krishnakanta Handique scholarship is awarded to students of classes V, VI and VII securing a minimum aggregate of 90% in the preceding class.
- Anandaram Barua Scholarship is awarded to students of classes VIII, IX and X securing a minimum aggregate of 85% in the preceding class.
- Banikanta Kakati scholarship was awarded to students who got rank in HSLC examination. It was also open to financially disadvantaged students who would obtain a minimum aggregate of 85% in HSLC examination.
- Tridib Bhattacharya scholarship is offered to students having potentiality in co-curricular areas. The scholarship is sponsored by the guardians in memory of our dedicated teacher Tridib Bhattacharya who died prematurely.
- Santadev Goswami scholarship is awarded to the topper from class IX to X.
- The school holds training sessions in Assamese, English, Social Science, Mathematics, Hindi, Pre-school, Fine Arts and Science subjects every year for the teachers of the schools which follow AJBEC's academic framework and guidance. Experts, along with the experienced teachers of the school, conduct the sessions.
- An English teachers training is also organized every year in memory of Prof. Uday Chandra Dutta. The programme is partly sponsored by the family of Late Dutta.
- Ramdhenu program during Summer Vacation to allow students to enjoy the vacation leisurely with creative works.

- The school also organizes Raktabh Dutta Choudhury Memorial North-East School Chess Competition every year jointly with the Mind Sports Foundation.
- Padmanath Gohainbaruah scholarship was awarded to students who scored rank in class XII final examination.
- Sibananda Sarma scholarship is awarded to one student in each stream who obtains 90% or more marks in aggregate in class XII final examination.
- AJB was selected by FASS (Friends of Assam and Seven Sister), on behalf of NASA, as the only school in the entire country to talk to astronaut Edward Mike Finke on board of ISS on 07 January 2009.
- A group of students participated in the project entitled 'Water rediscover' in 2011 organized by North Dakota State University, USA.
- In 2008 the AJB Trust instituted a Fellowship to be offered to an outstanding personality of Assam. Shri Ramen Baruah, the prominent composer and lyricist of Assam the first recipient.
- Sri Ananda Chandra Dutta, who was given the Honorary Doctorate in Science by Dibrugarh University, the learned botanist, was the second recipient of AJB Fellowship in 2010. In 2012 the noted performing artist in folk music Sri Basistha Dev Sharma, Burha Satradhhikar of Barpeta Satra, was the third recipient of AJB Fellowship. In 2014, Padmashree Jadav Payang, the Forest Man (Aranya Manab) of India was awarded the AJB Fellowship. Noted artist Neelpawan Barua was awarded the Fellowship in 2016. In 2018 Veteran actor and film personality Kulada Kumar Bhattacharjee was awarded the AJB Fellowship. In 2022 famous artist and filmmaker Pulak Gogoi was awarded the AJB Fellowship. In 2024, the fellowship was awarded to Sri Hemanta Dutta, noted playwright, lyricist and actor. In 2025 Assam noted actress Rina Borah was awarded AJB Fellowship.
- The Fellowship carries an amount of rupees eight thousand per month for a period of two years along with a citation and a memento.
- The AJB Trust initiated “AJB SANMAN” in 2014 to be offered to eminent personalities of the state. This award has so far been conferred upon-eminent artist Adya Sarma, veteran actor Priya Baishya, athlete Devajani Borah, popular football player Durga Boro & Alen Deuri in 2014; eminent artist Trailokya Dutta, educationist & linguist Dr. Pramod Ch. Bhattacharya, eminent artist Nuruddin Ahmed & pioneer of mobile theatre Achyut Lahkar in 2015; actor & film director Abdul Mazid in 2016; renowned Musician Sunil Dev and famous litterateur Yesse Dorjee Thongsi in 2017; noted singer Dwipen Baruah and famous litterateur Ranju Hazarika in 2018, eminent musicians Jitu Sarma and Tapan Bhattacharya (Jitu-Tapan) in 2019 and legendary Assamese actress Jnanada Kakati, noted educationist and music composer Dr. Birendra Nath Dutta, renowned singer Dr. Lakshahira Das, famous writer Eli Ahmed and eminent social worker Phani Chetia in 2022 ; eminent writer Rongbong Terang, educationist and linguist Bisheswar Hazarika, famous mountaineer Tarun Saikia and Manish Kumar Deka in 2023 ; Assam's veteran journalist and editor of the Assamese magazine Prantik, Pradip Baruah, prominent satriya dancer Jatin Goswami, renowned exponent of folk-culture, Binod Khanal in 2024. Prominent writer and journalist Haidar Hussain, famous writer Khirodhar Baruah and prominent sculptor of the country Biren Singha in 2025.


